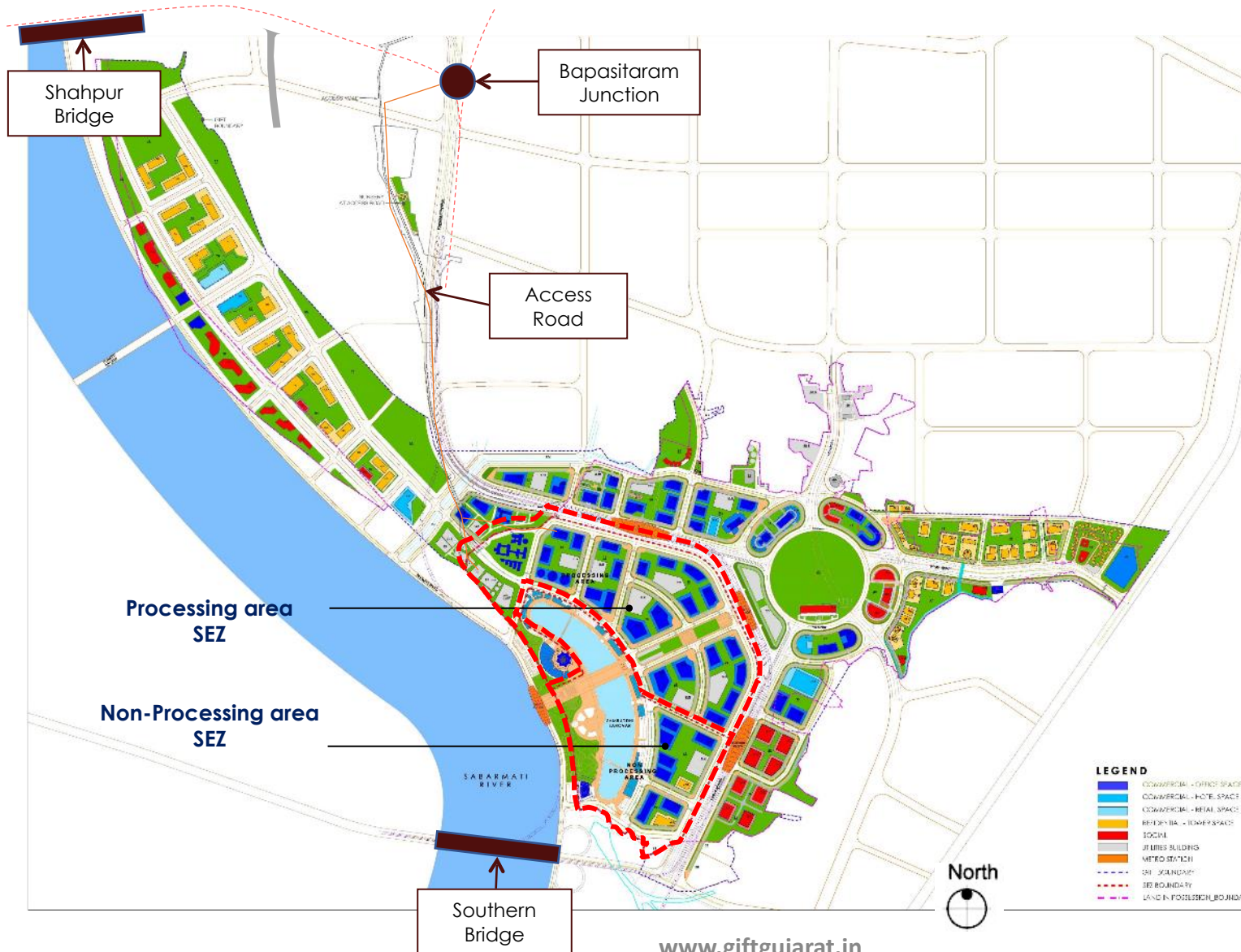
GIFT - Master Plan

Commercial: 67% (42 Mn SqFt)

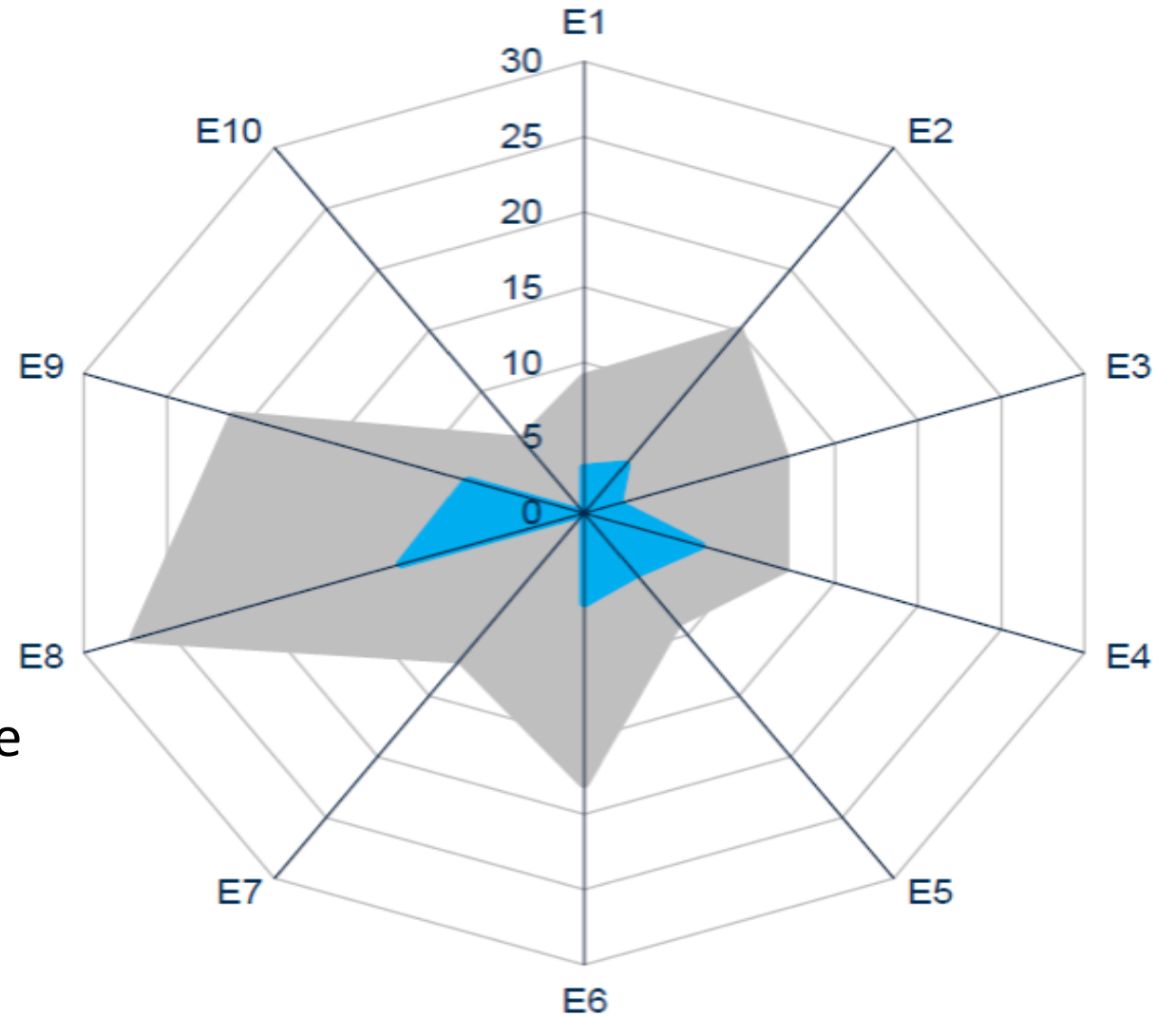
Resilience Scorecard – Preliminary Level Assessment



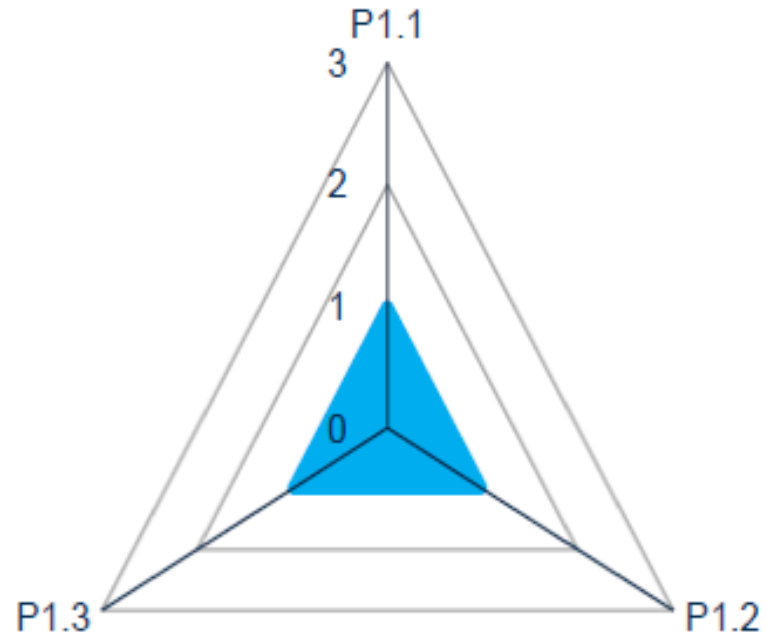
Overall score for the Preliminary Level Assessment at GIFT City

The overall score for this assessment is 45 / 141

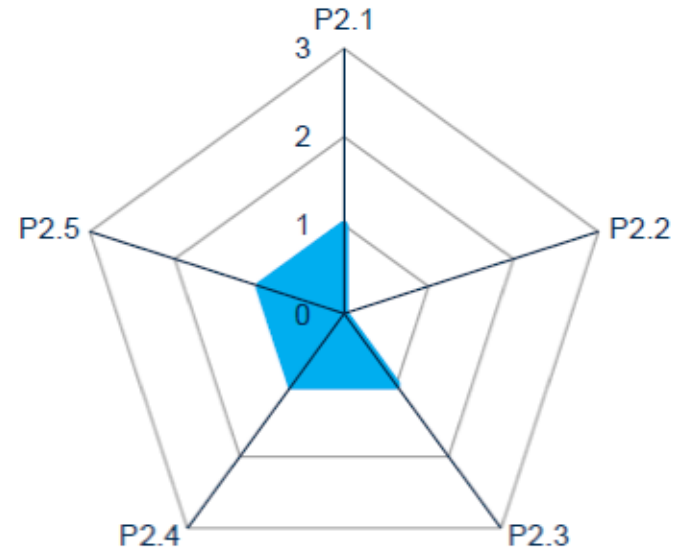

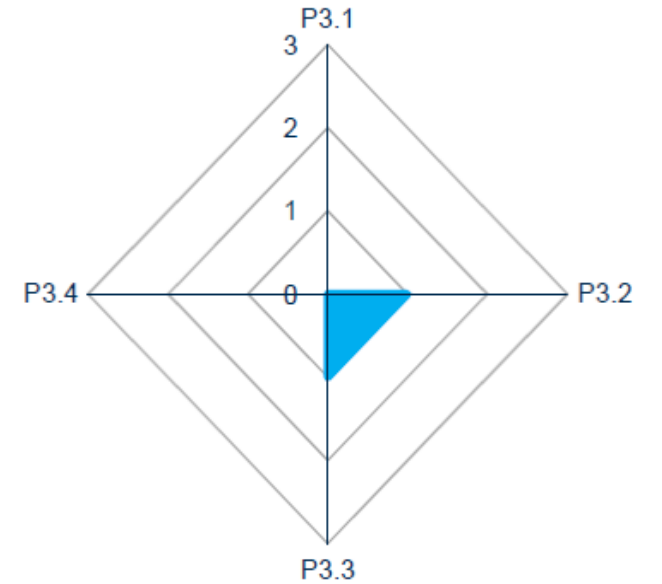

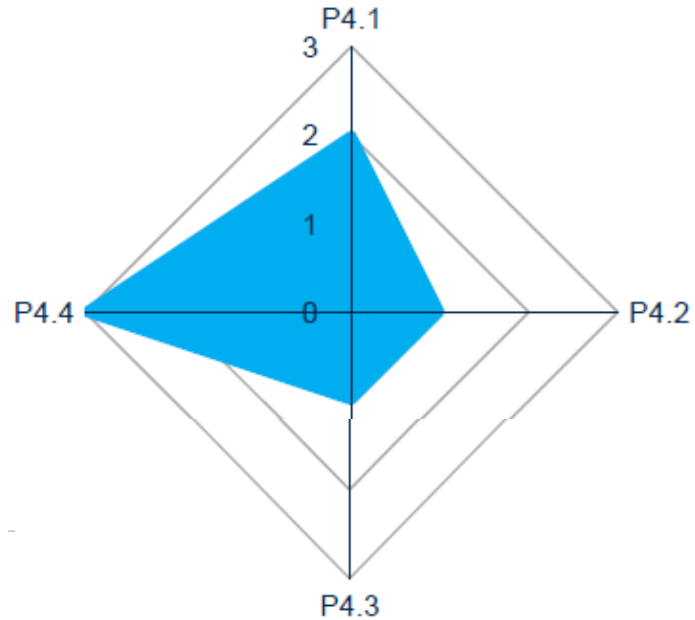

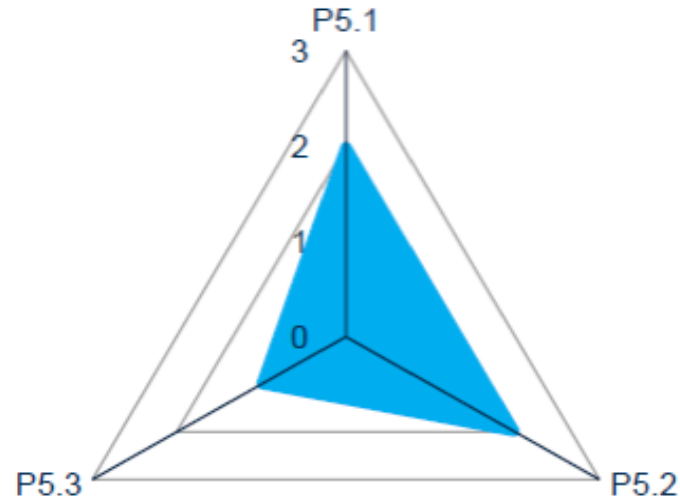

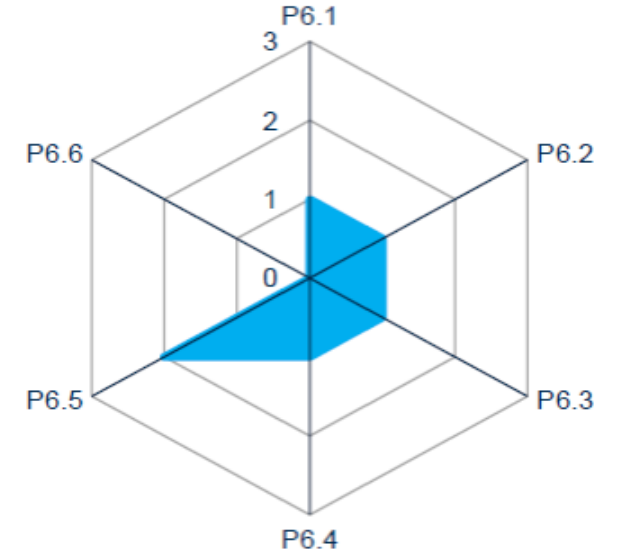

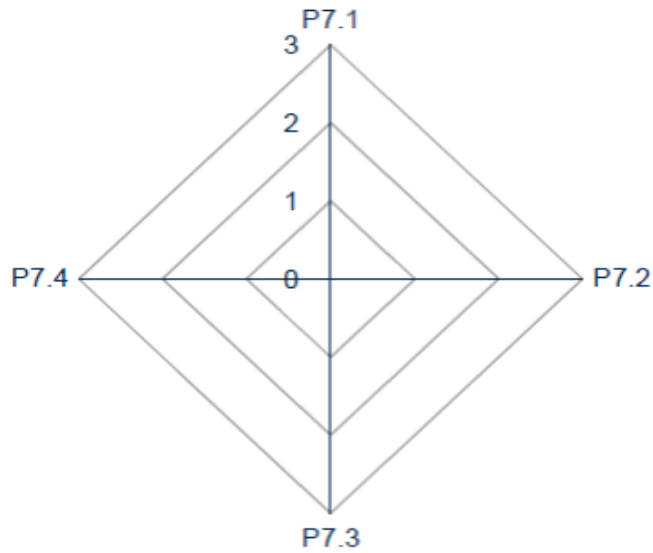

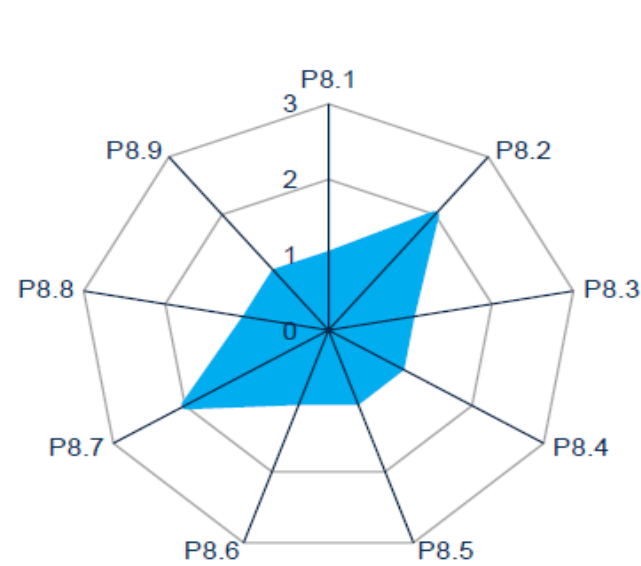

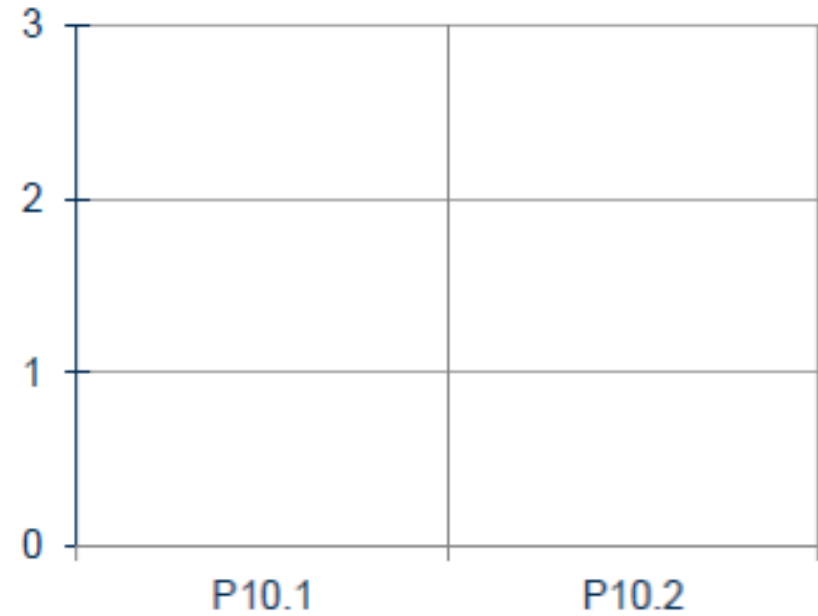
