**Dist. level outreach program for Panchayat Talati and Revenue Talati**

Topic: 'Coastal Community Resilience'

Dates: **25-July-2022 at Lokbharti Panchayat Raj Talim Kendra, Sanosara, Dist. Bhavnagar** and **26-27-July-2022 at Late B.V. Mehta Panchayat Raj Talim Kendra, Shashi Kunj, Dist. Junagadh.**

<b>1. Aim</b>		
To develop the capacities of target participants by linking their roles in DRM activities with field-level actions using appropriate technologies considering global perspectives and action at local level.		
<b>2. Background</b>		
Gujarat is multi-hazard state and is extremely prone to almost all major natural disasters. Specially, with the longest coastline of over 1600 km in the country, it is highly vulnerable to coastal hazards.		
As Bhavnagar and Junagadh district of Saurashtra regions have high Cyclone Risk and to build the capacity of Panchayat Talati as well as Revenue Talati, it is proposed to undertake a 3-day field level training programme on <b>Coastal Community Resilience</b> .		
<b>3. Objectives</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. To develop a sound understanding about Basics of DRM;</li><li>ii. To make participants understand local hazards and resulting risks.</li><li>iii. To enhance the knowledge of Panchayat Talati on Coastal Community Resilience;</li><li>iv. To encourage the use of available technical applications for DRM and Risk-Informed Development/Planning;</li><li>v. To promote Community-based DRM concept;</li><li>vi. To encourage strengthening of existing capacities through training.</li></ul>		
<b>4. Why Training on Coastal Community Resilience ?</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. Lack of awareness among various stakeholders about the coastal risk</li><li>ii. More emphasis on response rather than risk reduction.</li><li>iii. Absence of cyclone resistant features in non-engineered construction in rural areas</li><li>iv. Lack of formal training among professional in DRM</li><li>v. Lack of adequate preparedness and response capacity among various stakeholders groups</li></ul>
