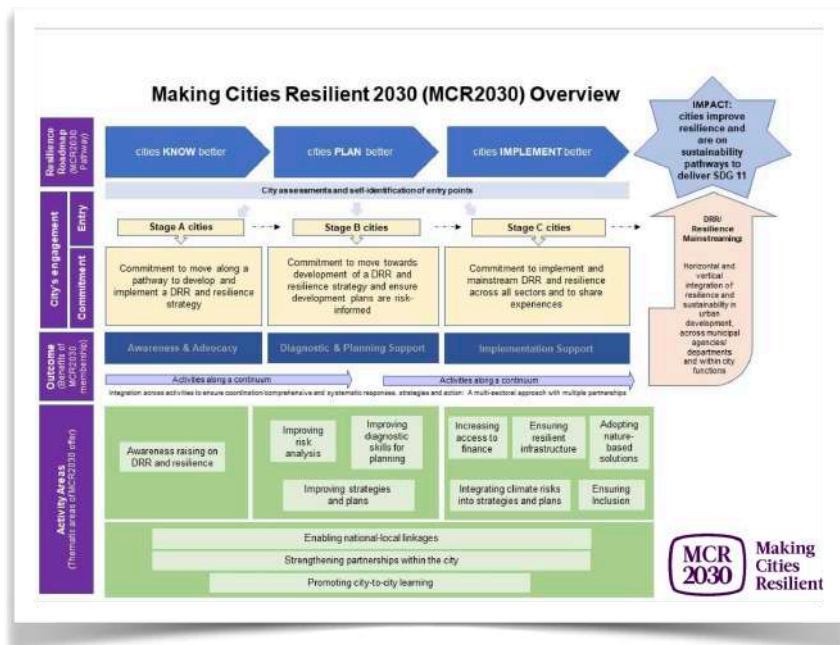


Making Cities Resilient (MCR) 2030: Prioritising DRR Actions & Plans in Gujarat (*for GIFT City*)

The Making Cities Resilient 2030 (MCR2030) is a unique cross-stakeholder initiative for improving local resilience through advocacy, sharing knowledge and experiences, establishing mutually reinforcing city-to-city learning networks, injecting technical expertise, connecting multiple layers of government, and building partnerships. Through delivering a clear roadmap to urban resilience, providing tools, access to knowledge and monitoring and reporting tools, MCR2030 will support cities on their journey to reduce risk and build resilience.

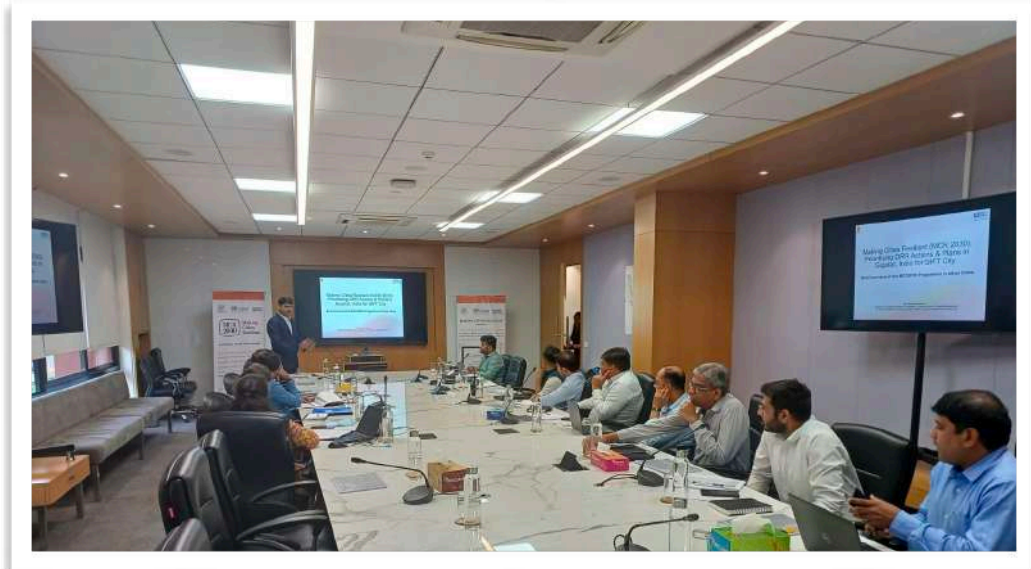


About GIFT City

GIFT CITY is the central pillar of the tri-city approach, located on the banks of the Sabarmati river between Ahmedabad and Gandhinagar, each 30 minutes away from one other. Ahmedabad boasts glorious history, Gandhinagar is the central hub of policy and decisions, and GIFT City is the main centre of the economy. It is India's first operational greenfield smart city and international financial services centre, which the Government of Gujarat promoted as a greenfield project.

Rationale of the Workshop

Using the Preliminary and Detailed Scorecard, it is easy to assess the risks in the city. These risks can be addressed through various measures like structural, non-structural, policy, legal, capacity building activities etc. It is required that these scorecard assessment are well converted into DRR actions and ultimately into plans. As GIFT City officials completed their scorecards, this workshop will help them to streamline their projects effectively.
