Additional challenges include handling long waiting times, respecting cultural and religious sensitivities, and ensuring adequate sanitation, comfort, and medical aid. Vulnerable groups such as children, the elderly, and individuals with disabilities require special attention to ensure their safety and well-being during such events.

To address these challenges, the **Gujarat Institute of Disaster Management (GIDM)** is organizing a specialized training program titled "**Managing Crowds at Mass Gathering Venues with Special Focus on Pavitra Yatra Dhams in Gujarat**". This program aims to equip participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to manage crowds effectively and implement fire safety measures, ensuring safer mass gatherings.
