

Based on the commitment on making schools safe and secure, we may plan to organize district level outreach activity on the subject with an objective:

- To orient the participants to various concepts of school safety and security in context with the risks pose by local hazards, WASH services, psycho-social safety physical health, cyber security and undesirable intentional human behaviours or actions;
- To develop an understanding among the participants on how to conduct a school safety and security assessment;
- To orient the participants on the legal and institutional provisions as mentioned and provisioned in the Right to Education Act and policy guidelines developed by National Disaster Management Authority and Ministry of Education;
- To develop an understanding among the participants about the components and planning process of a School Disaster Risk Management Plan;
- To establish the importance of learning continuity during emergency situations through alternate mechanisms and activity-based pedagogy;
- To capacitate School Safety Focal Point Teachers and Peer Educators (including DEOs, DPEOs, Sasanadhikari, BRCs/CRCs) through Master Trainers.

For the rollout of safety and security indicators at the school level, covering 54,647 schools, the master trainers can further train Cluster Resource Centres (CRCs) and each of the CRC members can train and handhold some 10-12 school (every CRC is responsible for approximately 10-12 schools) on forming SDMCs and SDRMP.
